The Archery Club was paid \$977.50 for teaching archery at The Villages Middle School for the 9 week term that ended the first week in March. - f. Targets 1 - 4 are set at 60 yards
- g. Targets 5 – 8 are set at 50 yards
- h. Targets 9 – 12 are set a 40 yards
