

REQUIREMENTS TO JOIN THE VILLAGES ARCHERY CLUB

Village Residents must Complete
Membership Application

Attend a Monthly Club Meeting and
present the Membership Application
with appropriate annual dues

Members new to archery must attend
at least one safety/training class
presented by The Villages Archery
Club

Members are expected to actively
participate in Club activities,
including shooting, work parties, and
Club functions/meetings

Members must abide by all rules and
guidelines of The Villages Archery
Club and / or The Villages Archery
Range.

Members must exercise due diligence
in the care and use of all Club
equipment and facilities

Members must not under any
circumstance disclose the
combination to The Villages Archery
Shop to any non-Club member, family
member, or friend. Violation of this
rule will be grounds for immediate
revocation of Club membership

Guidelines for New Members

All members must read and be aware of
the "Archery Range Rules", which are
posted at the range

Use of Archery Club Arrows

If you load arrows improperly in the bow
you may tear off a vane when you shoot
the arrow. Take care to load the arrows
so that the odd colored vane points out
away from the bow when the arrow is
nocked on the string. Not doing this will
result in damage to the arrow and even
the arrow rest because the odd colored
vane will strike the rest / bow when you
shoot.

You are also reminded to use **ONLY** the
arrows marked as "CLUB ARROWS"

It is every member's responsibility to
care for Club equipment. Our arrows
cost us about \$6 each and careless use
of this equipment will not be tolerated.

If you are using Club equipment, take
care of what you use.

Locking & Unlocking the Door at the Range

Enter the combination to both of the
locks to enter. When you shut the door,
the bottom lock will secure itself
automatically and the top deadbolt will
lock itself after approximately 45
seconds

Club members are prohibited from
disclosing the combination to the shop
door to another individual, especially
family members or guests.

Support of Club Activities

The Archery Club hosts Camp Villages,
Resident Clinics, and other activities.
Members are encouraged to support
these Club activities.
