Our 2018 Handicap League will begin Jan 15. Jeff Wiseman reviewed the status of the current season.

We finished the 2nd Term of archery classes with The Villages Middle School on 21 December. The club was paid \$701.25 for teaching this session. The 3rd term will begin on Thursday, 11 January 2018. We meet every Thursday afternoon at the field across from Buffalo Glen softball Complex at 3:00 to 4:30PM. We need help, so please come out and give us a hand.

I have asked Ken to order 250 medals (Gold only) to replenish our stock of medals.

During 2017 we had 258 shooters attend the seven (7) Tournaments we hosted. Our Tournaments for May and September we cancelled due to weather. We had total revenue to the club of \$2,580 from our \$10 per person registration fee. In addition, we sent \$738.30 to The Villages for Non-Residents who participated in our shoots.

The Social Committee will continue refreshments after every meeting Dec – April. We will also provide a table for anyone interested in “swapping or selling” used archery equipment. The last social event will be the fun shoot organized by Ken & Chrissy Thompson. Jane do you have anything on schedule from the Social Committee you would like to announce? As a reminder, if you move a target in any of the target positions from 1 through 12, it is your responsibility to return the target to its standard position before you leave the range. The standard positions are as follows:

Targets 1 - 3 are set at 60 yards

Targets 4 – 6 are set at 50 yards

Targets 7 – 9 are set a 40 yards
