We need at least four scores to establish a baseline handicap for each shooter. This is a fun league and we encourage new members to participate.

There is a lot of construction work in the range area. A new restroom facility is being constructed in the area just West of the current building and walking paths are being cut. Please use caution when in the area.

The club has a new device to assist pulling arrows from the new high density targets. The AroJac will be located in the shop on the shelf near the spine tester.

Several times recently, the door to the shop has been found unsecured and in one case, the door was ajar with no one in the shop or in the immediate area. PLEASE be sure the door to the shop is secured when you leave the building.

Addendum to Minutes

Locking & Unlocking the Door at the Range:

Enter the combination to both of the locks to enter. When you shut the door, the bottom lock will secure itself automatically but the top lock (the dead bolt) will not lock automatically. You MUST press the button labeled "Schlage" first and then turn the dead bolt to the left. If this is not done, the dead bolt will not be secured.

Club members are prohibited from disclosing the combination to the shop door to another individual, especially family members or guests.
