## New Business:

- 1 Our next scheduled tournament will be a **900 Round**, which we will host at the range on **Sunday, 4 May 2014**. We will not have another meeting before this tournament, so we need to plan for it tonight. I will pass around a **sign-up sheet** for you to sign if you plan on shooting this tournament. We will have a **work party on Thursday, 1 May, at 9:00AM** to set up the range.

2 We will also host another **900 Round Invitational Tournament** on **Sunday, 15 June**. We will have a club meeting before that shoot but would anyone like to volunteer tonight to handle registration or to run the line? We will have a work party to set up the range for this tournament on **Thursday, 12 June, at 9:00AM**. This will be the last tournament the club will host until 28 September.

3 Dillion and I are trying to secure **the old bathroom facility** at the range for use by the club. If we get approval, the plan is to move all of the **Recreation Department equipment and supplies** into the old bathroom space. This will allow for more space in our shop for the club equipment and material. We hope to get some final word on this issue before our next meeting. In addition, I have requested from Dillon a set of **keys for the new bathrooms**. The idea is to leave them in our shop in case they are ever needed to gain entry into the new bathrooms. 5 I would like to propose that we hold a "**Switch Shoot**" at the range on the next two **Thursday mornings at 9:00AM**. The idea here is that you must switch from your normal style of shooting to any other style of your choice. We would shoot five arrows per end (600 Round) at targets at **20, 30, and 40 yards**. Use of club equipment would be encouraged if you don't have equipment you could use otherwise. What are your thoughts?

6 At the recent Outdoor Expo, where the club had an Archery booth, it was noticed that the club had no **type of banner or club identification** to hang over our booth. Since then **Gery Stocker** has found a source for such an item and has ordered one for the club. Gery, will you tell us about this?

7 The **combination to the shop has been changed** and the old combination will no longer work. There is also a **new dead bolt installed**, that locks automatically.

8 As many of you know, we have yellow **club shirts** that we wear at club events or when we participate in competitions. The **club logos** are done on our shirts by **CUSTOM APPEARL**, which is located in the Southern Trace Shopping Center. Gery Stocker has found an inexpensive source for ball caps with the

club logo embroidered. He will go ahead and order a quantity that the club will sell to members

9 Arrows and Bows are provided for use by our members who don't have their own equipment. However, recently, some members have not been careful in the use of this equipment. The **ONLY** arrows that should be used are the ones in the arrow box located on the left side of the shop, as you enter the door.

10 As a reminder, **the ONLY way** you can **join** the Archery Club **or renew** your dues is at a club meeting. We are no longer accepting payment given to other persons or mailed in. **You must be present at a meeting to pay for your dues.**
