## New Business:

Our next scheduled shoot will be held on Sunday, 8 November. We will shoot the 900 Round.

- b. Run the Line:

We will not have another club meeting before this shoot, so we need to make plans for the tournament tonight. I'll pass around a sign-up sheet for those who want to shoot this tournament.

We will have a work party on Thursday, 5 November, at 9:00AM to set up the range for this tournament.

Both restrooms went "out of order" 30 minutes before our tournament started on Sunday. This seems to happen every time we have a tournament or whenever there is high demand/usage on the restrooms. It was suggested that the club buy an auger, so in the future we might be able to unclog the toilet on our own. The membership decided to purchase a professional quality snake to help keep the rest rooms operational during tournaments. Don Driscoll will take care of this.

Daylight Saving Time ends on 1 November and we will then return to Standard Time. This means that our Monday Morning Shoots beginning on 2 November will begin at 10:00AM. I will post a notice in our Bulletin board.

The resurfacing of the shooting line area has been completed after having our range closed for about 10 days. The range will be closed until Wed, Oct 14.

Our 2016 Handicap League will begin in January. Be thinking about this and we encourage everyone to get involved. More information will be provided in subsequent meetings.

During the winter months the club hosts "Learn To Shoot" clinics for Residents and Guest (No children). Typically we host these in January through April. I'll get a schedule put together by the next meeting.

The club decided tonight to increase the dues for new members, beginning Jan 1, 2016. The dues for new members only will go to \$25 for the first year only. Subsequent years renewals will still be \$10.

As a reminder, the only way you can join the Archery Club or renew your dues is at a club meeting. We are no longer accepting payment given to other persons or mailed in. You must be present at a meeting to pay your dues.

As many of you know, we have yellow club shirts that we wear at club events or when we participate in competitions. The club logos are done on our shirts by Cuscom Apparel, which is located in the Southern Trace Shopping Center. We also have club hat available.

As a reminder, if you move a target in any of the target positions from 1 through 12, it is your responsibility to return the target to its standard position before you leave the range. The standard positions are as follows:

Targets 1 - 4 are set at 60 yards  
Targets 5 – 8 are set at 50 yards  
Targets 9 – 12 are set a 40 yards
