

SHOOTING ETIQUETTE

1. Don't Hold-Up the Line:
 - ** Don't Keep Shooting
 - ** Look Up / Down the Line
 - ** Step Away From the Shooting Line
2. Be **Quiet**
3. Be Careful When Loading the Bow

SHOOTING ETIQUETTE (cont'd)

4. Don't Walk Of the Line Until Your "Partner" has shot his/her Last Arrow
5. Score Quickly & Return to the Line
6. Don't Spend "Excessive" Time Looking for Lost Arrows

TOURNAMENT TIPS

1. Slow Down - Alternate Shots
2. Mentally Rehearse the Next Shot -
Always Positive “Self-Talk”
3. Shoot for “Process” - not Score
4. Pay Attention to Your Groups
5. Let-Down / Let-Down / Let-Down

TOURNAMENT TIPS (cont'd)

6. Set Sight BEFORE Retrieving Arrows
7. Use Scope / Binoculars
8. Step Away From the Line
9. Don't touch or pull any Arrows before all Arrows are Scored.
10. Avoid Giving Advice, unless asked
11. Have a "Recovery Plan"
