Rod suggested that since the games are postponed but not cancelled, perhaps the Rec Dept will adopt a different strategy. A Suggestion was raised about Dudley possibly hosting some of our tournaments. Things to be considered:

1. What shape are the targets in.

2. Registration desk, chairs, and score board will need to be taken to Dudley then back to Paradise again.
3. Targets and awards will need to be taken to Dudley then back to Paradise again.
4. Lane Markers taken to Dudley, set up either the day before or early the morning of the shoot. Then return them to Paradise again.
5. Where do we set up the registration desk and still leave enough room for shooters to set bow cases and put their bows together, etc.
6. A reservation request has to be filed with the Rec. Center for a specific date and time then wait for approval.
7. Volunteers needed to run registration desk & Call the Line
8. The tournament would need to be advertised to, (non-tournament & non-club) shooters, so they are aware the range would be closed (no bulletin board at Dudley so this would have to be word of mouth)

Let's consider a FUN TYPE SHOOT with the entry fee being nonperishable food to be donated by the club.

- This would give opportunity to see what the Dudley range can handle.
- A chance to give Joe L. scoring program a test.
- A chance for the club to be recognized with food donation

Paradise and Dudley There seems to be a difference in the Rec Center's administration of the two ranges. Rod will attempt to get clarification. Here is what we know as of today:
