Club Incorporation, Tax Status, Insurance & Waiver

We are insured through the NFAA National Insurance Program brokered by the Sadler Sports and Recreation Insurance Company

Coverage from 5/4/22 - 5/4/23

Chartered Club General Liability: (\$1,000,000 per occurrence/\$3,000,000 aggregate per member club) Director & Officer Liability Coverage: (\$1,000,000 Limit) Participant Accident: (Excess Medical \$50,000 / AD&D \$10,000) Damage to rented premises: (\$300,00 per occurrence)

We are covered for all Club Sponsored Events such as Tournaments, Leagues, 3D Shots, Fun Shots, etc.

Coverage for Tournaments includes participants from outside The Villages.

We took the minimum coverage for up to 80 individuals for any Club Sponsored Event above.

This insurance does not cover individual members when shooting during non-Archery Club events, such as day to day shooting at either the Paradise or Dudley archery ranges That would fall under your own insurance coverage for medical and liability.

Following our insurance company's recommendations, Club equipment will no longer be available for membership usage. We anticipate that the archery equipment (bows and arrows) that is owned by the Club will be disbursed in the near future. The method of disbursement hasn't yet been determined.

Targets

If practicing on target face other than what's currently on target, Please Do Not put your practice target face on top of current target face and damage 2 target faces. Drop it down or remove it until you're done practicing.

If you can shoot tight groups PLEASE shoot different targets each time at the range

The first of each month on Monday mornings (at Paradise) we rotate target faces from 12 o'clock, to 3 o'clock, to 6, to 9. PLEASE when you come to the range abide by the target face position on Lanes 1-9. KEEP THEM WHERE THEY ARE

If you move a target to a different yardage, PLEASE return it to the yardage label on the column on the shooting lane.

Remember – Archery 101 requires the instructors to move Targets to 10 yard line – Help the instructors by moving the targets back to the correct position.
