Safety Considerations

Bows / Arrows / etc.

Periodically inspect your arrows for flaws, cracks lose nocks/points.

Inspect bow limbs, strings, serving and repair/replace when necessary.

Rec Dept. announcement about Crossbows

At this time only 1 dispensation has been granted

NFAA General Rules:

- The bow must have a handle/riser, two limbs, and a string.
- The bow must be able to be drawn with one hand while holding the bow's grip with the other hand.
- The bow has a maximum peak weight of 80 lbs or less.
- The bow shoots an arrow at 300 feet per second or less (variance of 3% is allowed)

Board position: Crossbows WILL NOT be accepted in any club event due to safety and NFAA rules/regulations. A letter will be sent to the Rec Dept.

### Targets

If practicing on target face other than what's currently on target, Please Do Not put your practice target face on top of current target face and damage 2 target faces. Drop it down or remove it until you're done practicing.

If you can shoot tight groups PLEASE shoot different targets each time at the range

Each Monday morning (at Paradise) we rotate target faces from 12 o'clock (first Monday of month), to 3 o'clock, to 6, to 9.

PLEASE when you come to the range abide by the target face position on Lanes 1-9. KEEP THEM WHERE THEY ARE

If you move a target to a different yardage, PLEASE return it to the yardage label on the column on the shooting lane. Remember – Archery 101 requires the instructors to move Targets to 10 yard line – Help the instructors by moving the targets back to the correct position.
