Access to Archery Club targets

Since pandemic access to Target Room has been restricted to club officers only.

We have tried numerous time to change this to no avail

BUT, we finally reached a MAJOR MILESTONE (compromise) with the Rec Dept.

- Granted permission to install shelves in shop
- Granted permission to NEATLY store club targets
- Reminded that Rec Dept. target faces are to be returned to targets when not using club target faces for testing or practice.

So how could we lose the permission we were just granted:

1. By leaving an Archery Club target face on the target when no longer being used. We are able to put any target face we want on a target for testing or practice, but we must reinstall the Rec Dept. 2'x2' 122cm target before we leave. Police Yourself
 1. If you want to shoot a different target face, take down the Rec Dept. target face and store it neatly as you must rehang it when you are done.
 2. When you put back the Rec Dept. 2'x2' 122cm target face on the target, put it back in the location you found it. Whether it was at 12:00, 3:00 etc. Look at another target for the current location.
 3. After you have used an Archery Club target face, return it neatly to the shelf you got it from. Every shelf is labeled with the target type that belongs on that shelf. If the shelves become a mess, we will lose this privilege. Police yourselves.
2. As everyone knows we have been losing tools more and more frequently lately. If a large number of targets start walking out the door with no explanation, we will lose this privilege.

Again, this was a major milestone for the club, let's not abuse it.

Status/Updates on Paradise & Dudley Ranges

Targets

If practicing on target face other than what's currently on target, Please Do Not put your practice target face on top of current target face and damage 2 target faces. Drop it down or remove it until you're done practicing.

If you can shoot tight groups PLEASE shoot different targets each time at the range

Each Monday morning (at Paradise) we rotate target faces from 12 o'clock (first Monday of month), to 3 o'clock, to 6, to 9.

PLEASE when you come to the range abide by the target face position on Lanes 1-9. KEEP THEM WHERE THEY ARE

If you move a target to a different yardage, PLEASE return it to the yardage label on the column on the shooting lane. Remember – Archery 101 requires the instructors to move Targets to 10 yard line – Help the instructors by moving the targets back to the correct position.
