Our First Attempt:

Jan 16th will be a club Vegas Round at Paradise

- **Entry fee has been waived**
- 3 Arrows shot in 10 ends (*total of 30 arrows*) *At 20 yards*

- We will shoot **TWO** events for total possible score of 600
- Per Rec Dept. we **MUST** follow all COVID rules.
 - If not on the shooting line masks must be worn at all times.
 - 1 shooter per lane at a time (*we may need A & B squads*)
 - Lanes 1&2 score each other, 3&4 score each other, etc.
 - Only pull your arrows
- **Rod** will call the line
- Rachel & Charlie C. will run registration desk (good opportunity for volunteers to learn)
- **9:00am start time**
- **Registration requested; however, walk ups will be allowed**
- **Rachel is unavailable, Dee will work with Charlie C.**
- **Participants must bring their own mask. The club is **not** providing masks.**

A Suggestion has been raised about Dudley possibly hosting some of our tournaments. Things to be considered:

1. What shape are the targets in.
2. Registration desk, chairs, and score board will need to be taken to Dudley then back to Paradise again.
3. Targets and awards will need to be taken to Dudley then back to Paradise again.
4. Lane Markers taken to Dudley, set up either the day before or early the morning of the shoot. Then return them to Paradise again.
5. Where do we set up the registration desk and still leave enough room for shooters to set bow cases and put their bows together, etc.
6. A reservation request has to be filed with the Rec. Center for a specific date and time then wait for approval.
7. Volunteers needed to run registration desk & Call the Line
8. The tournament would need to be advertised to, (non-tournament & non-club) shooters, so they are aware the range would be closed (no bulletin board at Dudley so this would have to be word of mouth)

Let's consider a FUN TYPE SHOOT with the entry fee being nonperishable food to be donated by the club.

- This would give opportunity to see what the Dudley range can handle.
 - A chance to give Joe L. scoring program a test.
 - A chance for the club to be recognized with food donation
 - If anyone is willing to get the ball rolling Rod and would be willing to help.
 - Get some volunteers and schedule a get together to brainstorm ideas.
