There was a discussion regarding activities at both ranges and how to promote archery at both places. Nearly half of the meeting attendees tonight primarily shoot at the Dudley range and are looking for Club activities at Dudley. This is something that the Club should be working on. More to come.

Target Reminders:

Target faces on Lanes 1 – 9 are rotated every Monday morning to one of the following clock positions: 12, 3, 6, 9. If you replace a target face or use a patch, look at Targets 1 – 9 and PLEASE FOLLOW THIS PROCEDURE.

If you move a target in any of the target positions from Lanes 1 through 17, it is your responsibility to return the target to its standard position before you leave the range. The standard positions are posted on each lane and are as follows:

- a. Targets 1 - 3 are set at 60 yards
- b. Targets 4 - 6 are set at 50 yards
- c. Targets 7 - 9 are set at 40 yards
- d. Targets 10 - 12 are set at 20 yards
- e. Targets 13 - 17 are set at 10 yards

The 15th of every month some members of the Club members meet at Spanish Springs Town Center for a social gathering. Everyone is invited to attend. Mary Ann gets there around 7:00PM and is holding a flag. Try and wear something yellow or archery related.

The Club Library is a very extensive collection of Archery books, CD, and video tapes that are available to all club members. Jim Murray is our club Librarian and he will be happy to check out any of this material to you to take home and enjoy.
