The smaller faces cost just over a buck whereas the 122cm faces cost nearly 5 bucks. Please stagger these faces to optimize wear. If we need the full size faces for the Monday morning shoots, they can be put up and then taken down and the smaller faces can be used. Discussion regarding target placement.
