We will have a work party on Friday, 12 June, at 9:00AM to set up the range for this tournament. (NOTE: Friday not Thursday due to Camp Villages)

The 2015 Camp Villages Archery Schedule has been established by The Villages as follows:

Thursday, 11 June, from 9:00AM to Noon

This means our first Camp Villages session will be on 11 June. (there were 36 kids signed up and we had enough help). Dillon advised that the next Camp Villages (9 July) was sold out (over 60 kids). We will need plenty of help on that day.

We will need someone to run Camp Villages on the 2<sup>nd</sup> session on July 9 and many of our members will be at the national tournament in Minnesota.

The club recently has acquired six Mathews Genesis bows. These bows are set at 20lbs which is equivalent to a 35lb recurve. There is zero let-off with these bows in contrast to normal compound bows which have 65% to 80% let-off so they will shoot very similar to a recurve. There are no specific draw length requirements. These bows will fit nearly everyone (15" to 30" draw length). We now have 9 right handed bows and 3 left handed. We will soon have additional arrows.

There was a discussion regarding replacing the bow racks that are on the range with another type, possible with some type of hangers. If anyone has any ideas, please let us know.

We now have three new arrow storage racks in the shop for different size arrows. Please replace arrows in the proper rack.

Target faces:

When replacing target faces, please use the 122cm target faces on lanes 1 through 12. Use the 80cm faces on 13 through 17. The 92cm targets are not for general use as they are hard to come by and they are only used for the Classic 600 round.

As a reminder, the ONLY way you can join the Archery Club or renew your dues is at a club meeting. We are no longer accepting payment given to other persons or mailed in. You must be present at a meeting to pay your dues.

As many of you know, we have yellow club shirts that we wear at club events or when we participate in competitions. The club logos are done on our shirts by Custom Apparel, which is located in the Southern Trace Shopping Center.

As a reminder, if you move a target in any of the target positions from 1 through 12, it is your responsibility to return the target to its standard position before you leave the range. The standard positions are as follows:

Targets 1 - 4 are set at 60 yards

Targets 5 – 8 are set at 50 yards

Targets 9 – 12 are set a 40 yards

A notice will be posted at the range indicating the correct target positions
