New Business:

We will host our last 900 Round tournament of this summer on Saturday, 29 June. We will have our June club meeting before this shoot, so we can make plans for the shoot at that meeting. We will not host another shoot until 13 October, when we will Shoot our Classic 600 Round as the Larry Boyd Memorial Tournament.

We will begin our second season of the Summer Handicap League this month. Charlie Wilson will run the League. Charlie Wilson gave a recap of league activities.

As a reminder, if you move a target in any of the target positions from #1 through #9, it is your responsibility to return the target to its standard position before you leave the range. The standard positions are as follows:

- a. Targets 1 - 3 are set at 60 yards
- b. Targets 4 – 6 are set at 50 yards
- c. Targets 7 – 9 are set at 40 yards
