1. Our next scheduled tournament will be a **900 Round,** which we will host at the range on **Sunday, 9 November.** We will not have another meeting before this tournament, so we need to plan for it tonight. I will pass around a **sign-up sheet** for you to sign if you plan on shooting this tournament. We will have a **work party**

on Thursday, 6 November, at 9:00AM to set up the range. Do I have volunteers for running the line or registration?

2. We will also host another **900 Round Invitational Tournament on Sunday, 14 December**. We will have club meetings before that shoot but would anyone like to volunteer tonight to handle registration or to run the line? We will have a work party to set up the range for this tournament on **Thursday, 11 November, at 9:00AM**.

3. I have submitted our **2015 Tournament Schedule** to the Florida Archery Association (FAA). Our 2015 Shoot Schedule is:

We will also schedule a club wide Classic 600 tournament sometime in late fall.

4. I would like to propose that henceforth our September Invitational Tournament be declared "**The Larry Boyd Memorial Tournament**". This was endorsed.

5. Our club is in need of more **medals, especially GOLD Medals**. Ken will you discuss this for us? Ken presented several option for purchasing medals and it was decided to stay with the high quality medals we are currently using.

6. I would like to propose that we continue holding our "**Switch Shoots**" at the range on **Thursday mornings**. Starting times would coincide with the start times for our Monday Morning Shoots. The idea here is that you must switch from your normal style of shooting to any other style of your choice. We would shoot five arrows per end (600 Round) at targets at **20, 30, and 40 yards**. Use of club equipment would be encouraged, if you don't have equipment you could use otherwise. What are your thoughts? This was endorsed and will begin this thursday, Oct 16.

7. **On 2 November** we will return to **Standard Time** and therefore, our Monday Morning Shoots will begin at **10:00AM**. When we return to Daylight Savings Time on 8 March, we will return to the 9:00AM start time.

8. The club is missing **ALL** of the three finger under **TABS** that were in our shop. Does anyone have any information about the whereabouts of these tabs? They were

the ones that were yellow and orange in color. Ken will order more tabs from Lancaster.

9. I have been asked by some club members if it would be possible to designate our range as a **“No Smoking Area”**. It is my opinion, that such a restriction would not be possible due to our range being an outside area. All Recreatio venues are designated as non smoking. Dillon will be asked again to have signs installed.
10. As many of you know, we have yellow **club shirts** that we wear at club events or when we participate in competitions. The **club logos** are done on our shirts by **CUSTOM APPEARL**, which is located in the Southern Trace Shopping Center. We also have a few more Club Hat available.
11. As a reminder, if you move a target in any of the target positions from 1 through 12, it is your responsibility to **return the target to its standard position** before you leave the range. The standard positions are as follows:
 - a. Targets 1 - 4 are set at 60 yards
 - b. Targets 5 – 8 are set at 50 yards
 - c. Targets 9 – 12 are set a 40 yards
12. As a reminder, **the ONLY way** you can **join** the Archery Club **or renew** your dues is at a club meeting. We are no longer accepting payment given to other persons or mailed in. **You must be present at a meeting to pay for your dues.**
