

The Villages Archery Club

Meeting Minutes November 13, 2023

Opened meeting with Welcome and Pledge of Allegiance. 44 members in attendance.

Five new members/guests introduced themselves.

Old Business:

- The open Tournament and Public Relations Coordinator positions were discussed and there were no volunteers.
- We are still looking for 12-14 individuals to sign-up for the CPR/AED class so we can schedule it.
- Mike Sellers is looking into the availability of a group shooting at Silver Springs
- The electronic voting process was discussed. Inputs to the recent draft will be incorporated and the final version of the Electronic Voting Process document will be posted to the website. Also discussed was the need for an electronic, versus in-person voting process. The purpose of the electronic process was to provide more members the ability to cast their votes. However, there are some club members that may have a challenge voting electronically. It was decided to retain the electronic voting process, and provide more time for voting, so those that need assistance have time to get it.
- It was mentioned that the Bylaws will be updated once the club has a full Board again. A draft update has been started, to incorporate changes to VP responsibilities, as well as the club's official non-profit status. Once the Board has completed all of the draft updates, it will be sent to the membership for review and comment, before final release.

Officer Reports:

- **Secretary:** Reminder that membership dues are due by the end of the year. A new application and waiver are required.
- **Paradise Range:** Dick provided a demonstration on how the targets should be rotated each week.
- **Dudley Range:** Jim reminded everyone that Archer 101 is not being offered at Dudley in November, so Paradise may be getting a larger than normal number of students.
- **Tournaments:** Paul provided the results from the Larry Boyd Memorial, State Target Archery, State Field Archery, and Golden Age Games tournaments. He stated that the

VAC made a great showing at all of these events and that that participation is encouraging others to come to our events.

- **Fun Shoots:** Jerry reminded everyone that the next Fun Shoot is 9:00 November 20, at Dudley and the theme is William Tell. He also mentioned that the next several Fun Shoots may start at 10:00 because of the cooler weather coming. See our new link [HERE](#) showing the previous month's participation.
- **Leagues:** Donna provided the results (*see Meeting Agenda Presentations below for details*) of the recently completed 300 League. She presented the awards accordingly. She also announced that there will be at least 5 leagues in 2024, with two leagues starting in January; a normal 600 league (60-50-40) and a 600-mini (30-20-10), geared toward newer shooters.
- **Social Committee:** Sunny thanked everyone for the successful picnic held on Nov. 12. A pot-luck holiday party was suggested to be held during the next club meeting. The consensus in the room was to have a potluck dinner for the December meeting and move the anticipated swap meet to the January meeting.
- **Website:** Charlie mentioned a significant amount of traffic on the club's [Classified site](#) and encouraged members to take a look.
- **Treasury:** Jim reviewed the October month end financials (*see Meeting Agenda Presentations below for details*).

New Business:

- **2024-25 Officer elections:**
- The Nomination Committee provided the slate of candidates for the Officer positions (*see Meeting Agenda Presentations below for details*). The floor was then opened for walk-on or self-nominations. There were no new nominations from the floor.
 - Paul reviewed the electronic voting process and timeline. It was mentioned that with only one candidate for each officer position, the voting seemed unnecessary. However, since the bylaws call for a vote, it will be conducted and we can take lessons-learned to continue to refine the process.
- **November 18 Tournament:** Paul mentioned that we already have a significant number of non-Villagers signed up for the tournament, but not very many club members yet. He encouraged everyone who wanted to participate to register on the website. He further mentioned that the club will be providing lunch for this event. He called for volunteers to help run the event and got several volunteers. *See Meeting Agenda Presentations below for future Events.*
- **Swap Meet:** It was decided to hold a swap meet just before the January Club meeting.
- **Other New Business:** Ken mentioned that the target frames at both ranges are getting moldy and need power-washed and retreated. Since the frames are maintained by The Villages, Paul took the action to put the requests into the appropriate Rec Centers.

Jim Murray provided an overview of the Club Treasurer's responsibilities (*see Meeting Agenda Presentations below for details*).

The planned video incurred technical difficulties, so the meeting was adjourned with an inspiration message. Cookies were enjoyed by all.
