We cancelled our 600 Round scheduled for 8 October due to Hurricane Matthew.

The work on the fence around the range has been completed.

We will host a 900 Round on Sunday, 6 November 2016. The shoot will beginning at 9:00AM. We will not have another club meeting before that tournament, so we need to plan for it tonight. I will pass around a sign-up sheet for anyone who intends to shoot. Sign-up will also be available via email, which Charlie will send out to the membership. Note that Daylight Savings Time ends on 6 November, so set your clocks back. Would anyone like to volunteer to help with the running of this tournament?

We will have a work party on Thursday, 3 November, at 9:00AM to set up the range for this tournament.

The final design in our target stands has been agreed upon. We will submit this design to The Villages, who will subsequently build the stands for us. We hope to replace all old stands with new ones over the winter months.

Our Monday Morning shoots will begin at 10:00AM beginning on 7 November due to the end of Daylight Savings Time.

Our 2017 Winter Handicap League will begin in mid-January. If you wish to participate you need to get some scores posted for the 600 Round, so a handicap can be established for you. You can get these scores by attending the Monday Morning Shoots.

The December 12 meeting will be held in the Adams Room at Laurel Manor. This room is in the far left back corner of the rec center.

In November or December, we will be trying something new at the range. We will be having informal 20 yard shoots on Thursday morning. These should be fun shoots and they will get us ready for the first three 20 yard tournaments of 2017.

Beginning at the November meeting, dues renewals for 2017 will be collected. New members who join at or after the October meeting will be paid through the following year.

The Club Library is a very extensive collection of Archery books, CD, and video tapes that are available to all club members. Jim Rosenmeier is our club Librarian and he will be happy to check out any of this material to you to take home and enjoy.

As a reminder, the ONLY way you can join the Archery Club or renew your dues is at a club meeting. Dues for new members are \$25. Dues for members who renew their membership will be \$10. We do not accept payment given to other persons or mailed in. You must be present at a meeting to pay your dues.

As many of you know, we have yellow club shirts that we wear at club events or when we participate in competitions. The club logos are done on our shirts by Custom Apparel, which is located in the Southern Trace Shopping Center. We also have Club Hat available.

As a reminder, if you move a target in any of the target positions from 1 through 12, it is your responsibility to return the target to its standard position before you leave the range. The standard positions are as follows:

Targets 1 - 3 are set at 60 yards

Targets 4 – 6 are set at 50 yards
Targets 7 – 9 are set at 40 yards
