The range will be closed for the remainder of the week to allow fence replacement. If the workers finish early, a notification will be sent to the membership. The range opening will depend on favorable weather.

There will be a work party on Thursday, Sep 22 at 9AM to prepare the range for the tournament on the 25<sup>th</sup>. There are several centers that need to be replaced and several stands need repair. This will be the first work party in over three months since the last tournament back in June.

It is your responsibility to insure that the archery room is secure when leaving the room. The combination is for your use only, not friends or family and is not to be given to anyone not a member of the club.

It has been reported that hornets nests have been found behind the paper targets on a few of our stands. Please use caution.

There is a continuing issue regarding placement of the targets when shooters are done for the day. Every afternoon, the targets have to be relocated to ten yards for the recreation programs. There are placards on the shelter columns that indicate the proper distance for the targets. Your cooperation will be appreciated.

There was a discussion regarding the target stands. We need to reach a decision soon weather the prototype (number 8) is OK or are further modifications needed. The Villages are anxious to get the new stands started.

Many of our shooters often shoot at other local tournaments and senior games here in Florida and nearby states. We will be looking at some kind of online notification or listing where shooters going to these tournaments can find others who might like to go to the same shoot. The goal is to try to coordinate transportation and so shooters may know who else is going. Perhaps we might consider a tournament coordinator who would facilitate getting this information out to the membership? Stay tuned?

As a reminder, the only way you can join the Archery Club or renew your dues is at a club meeting. Dues for new members are \$25. Dues for members who renew their membership will be \$10. We do not accept payment given to other persons or mailed in. You must be present at a meeting to pay your dues. Beginning this year, we will be accepting 2017 renewals starting at the November meeting. New members who join at or after the October meeting will be paid up for the following year.

As many of you know, we have yellow club shirts that we wear at club events or when we participate in competitions. The club logos are done on our shirts by Custom Apparel, which is located in the Southern Trace Shopping Center. Club hats are also available.

As a reminder, if you move a target in any of the target positions from 1 through 12, it is your responsibility to return the target to its standard position before you leave the range. The standard positions are as follows:  
Placards have been placed on the uprights indicating where the targets for that lane should be.

It is our understanding that The Villages will be building the new target stands once the final design has been approved.
